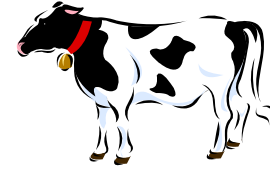

NOTE: ALL EXHIBITORS MUST NOTIFY THE SUPERINTENDENT IF THEY EXPECT TO EXHIBIT, NOT LATER THAN JULY 1ST - PHONE. 376-2039. IF THE BARN IS NOT FULL, WE WILL OPEN TO ADJOINING COUNTIES.

ATTENTION: ALL EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KEEP THEIR EXHIBITS CLEAN AND NEAT FOR THE ENTIRE WEEK. EXHIBITORS THAT DO NOT ABIDE BY THESE RULES ARE SUBJECT TO EXCLUSIVE AND LOSS OF PREMIUM CHECK.

- ❖ **DAIRY EXHIBITORS-TAKE NOTE:** THE DAIRY INDUSTRIAL BUILDING HAS MILKING FACILITIES FOR THE USE BY ALL EXHIBITORS, IF NEEDED. ALL MILK COLLECTED, WILL BE DONATED TO THE DAIRY BUILDING FOR FUTURE RENOVATIONS. ALL EXHIBITORS USING THEIR OWN MILKING FACILITIES MAY ALSO DONATE THEIR MILK TO THE DAIRY BUILDING.
 - 1. An exhibitor may show as many animals as he has entered in single classes. An exhibitor may show only one entry in a group class, except get-of-sire, junior get-of- sire, dam –daughter, and produce of dam and pairs. No exhibitor may receive more than two premiums in any class.
 - 2. Animals comprising a herd or group need not be named in application for entry, but Said herd or group must consist of animals entered in the individual classes. Exhibitors must indicate the number for which he desires to make entry in the herd Or group prizes. **NOTE:** At time of showing either herds or groups, exhibitor must supply the ring clerk with name and registration papers of various animals comprising the herd or group. The Superintendent and clerks may then check registration papers in the group classes while they are in the ring. No premium will be paid unless these papers are available.
 - 3. All cattle must be owned 30 days prior to the opening of the Lewis County Fair by the individuals of firms exhibiting same in the Dairy Cattle breeds. Where a herd is registered in the names of different members of the family, residing on one farm, and where the herd is a unit, all entries may be considered as a single exhibitor. Exceptions to above ownership rule are at the discretion of the cattle superintendent as petitioned by 4-H agent or FFA advisor.
 - 4. Firms or co-partnerships entering animals for competition must be in existence 30 days prior to the date of closing entries and in all cases must be bonafide, and affidavits of the age of the firms may be required by the management. Firms or co-partnerships entered into for show purposes will not be considered as bred by the company. Should a temporary sale or transfer of a show animal ever be discovered, the exhibitor and proper owner may be barred from all future shows.
 - 5. All animals shown in partnerships, which partnership has been in existence 30 days prior to the date of closing of entries may be shown in the name of a part owner, but the facts of the partnership must be stated at time of entry, and the animals must appear in the same part owner's name through all classes wherein entered.
 - 6. Any artificial means of removing or remedying physical defects or conformation in exhibition animals, such as lifting or filling under the skin, will be considered as fraud and deception. All animals giving evidence of such treatment will be barred from exhibition.
 - 7. Exhibitors must have their stock on the Fairgrounds not later than 9:00 p.m. Monday.
 - 8. Exhibition cattle will be released at 8:00 p.m., DST, Saturday, last day of Fair.
 - 9. No animals will be passed upon by the judges or awarded a prize, whose attendant does not carry or show proper catalog numbers for the lot exhibiting. For group classes the leaders shall display the individual numbers for each animal in the group. In addition, the catalog number of the group shall be carried by the attendant in charge of the group.
 - 10. All substitutions and class changes must be in the hands of the cattle superintendent by 10:00 a.m. Tuesday, except for fresh cows which may be changed from dry cow to milking class up to the time class enters the ring.
 - 11. The judge may, at his discretion, require any animal to be milked before him in the ring.
 - 12. The decision of the judges shall be final in all cases except where error, mistake, fraud, misrepresentation, or collusion not discovered at the time of the award, is proven. In such cases the decisions of the superintendent of the Cattle Department or such referees as he may appoint shall be final.
 - 13. Upon the request on the Superintendent of Cattle exhibitors must furnish animals to be used in the Youth Judging Contest.
 - 14. Exhibitors must parade their animals when requested to do so by the Superintendent of Cattle. Failure to do so entail forfeiture of prizes awarded.
 - 15. The Superintendent of Cattle is authorized and empowered to cause the removal from the buildings and grounds of any and all animals failing to meet the health conditions herein specified.
 - 16. The management assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to stock or other exhibits from any cause, and reserves the right to order any examination or test deemed necessary to determine the existence of any suspected disease or conditions in any animal exhibited.
 - 17. The rules printed herein are made part of the conditions under which all entries of exhibitors are made, and exhibitors are respectfully requested to read them carefully, thereby avoiding confusion at the time of the Fair.
- a.) A Banner will be presented to the "Supreme Champion" of all Dairy Breeds as designated by the judge.
 - b.) A Plaque will be presented to the "3 Best Females" of all Dairy Breeds, donated by the Lewis County Chamber of Commerce.
