DEPARTMENT 5 - SECTION 1- FLOWER DISPLAYS
(Amateurs Only)

Class 1. Shadow boxes (24" x 24" x 11 deep).
Limited to first six exhibitors.

Display by organizations or individuals. (May consist of garden flowers, house plants, dried material, baskets and vases of flowers, designs, etc.) Each exhibit receiving an award of 75 or more points will receive \$6.00 and a blue ribbon. Each exhibit receiving an award of 50-74 points will receive \$4.00 and a red ribbon.

Class 2. "BREAKFAST IN BED

Limited to first four exhibitors.

AWARDS: 1st - \$5.00 2nd - \$4.00 3rd - \$3.00 4th - \$2.00

Arrangement for a tray. Must include arrangement, tray, dishes and napkin. Placemat may be used. No silverware. Accessories permitted.

Class 3. DOOR DECORATION

Limited to first four exhibitors.

AWARDS: 1st. - \$5.00 2nd. - \$4.00 3rd. - \$3.00 4th. - \$2.00

A standard size neutral color door will be provided. Decoration must include dried material. Fresh flowers placed in a container that holds water may be used. Some artificial material may be used.

Class 4. DINNER TABLES

AWARDS: 1st. - \$6.00 2nd. - \$5.00 3rd. - \$4.00 4th - \$3.00

Setting for two. Limited to first four exhibitors.

Tables 42" round will be provided. Fresh and/or dried material may be used. Tablecloth should be round or two square ones could be used. The tablecloth must have at least a 10 inch drop. Make sure the cloth does not touch the floor.

Class 5-Tables "TEA AND COOKIES"

Limited to first four exhibitors.

AWARDS: 1st. - \$5.00 2nd. - \$4.00 3rd. - \$3.00 4th - \$2.00

"Tea & Cookies" for one on a 20" round table. Tables will be provided. Fresh &/or dried plant material can be used. Tablecloth should have at least a 10 inch drop. Two squares might work. Make sure cloth doesn't touch the floor. Exhibit must include arrangement, tablecloth, dishes, napkin, cup & saucer. No silverware.
